**Memorandum of Association
of
The Dehra Dun Club Ltd.**

- (1) The name of the club shall be the Dehra Dun Club Limited.
- (2) The Registered office of the Club shall be at Dehra Dun on the premises known as the Dehra Dun Club and numbered 56 in the Dehradun Dun Local Registry or at such other place as the Committee may from time to time appoint.
- (3) The objects for which the Club is established are :-
 - i) To afford to its Members all the usual privileges, advantages, conveniences and accommodation of a club.
 - ii) To promote social intercourse and to provide entertainments and healthy recreation for its Members.
 - iii) To take over the effects and liabilities of the present unincorporated Association known as the Dehra Dun Club.
 - iv) From time to time to borrow monies which may be required for the purpose of the Club, on security of the Club's property, or otherwise by taking loans or issuing debentures.
 - v) To purchase, take on lease or hire, or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property or any rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Club.
 - vi) To construct, alter, or keep in repair any buildings required for or used by the Club.
 - vii) To invest the money of the Club not immediately required upon such securities as may, from time to time, be determined on by the committee.
 - viii) To join, amalgamate or reciprocate with any other Club or Association, whether incorporated or not, intended for the promotion of any object in which the Club is interested.
 - ix) To sell, improve, manage, develop, lease, mortgage, dispose off or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the club, including power to sell wines, spirits and other stores to Members not residing in the Club premises or for consumption outside those premises.
 - x) Dehra Dun Club Ltd. Dehra Dun incorporated under the Indian Companies Act as a Limited Company/Association formed for the purpose not of gains.
 - xi) Generally to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- (4) Every Member of the Club undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Club in the event of the same being wound up during the time he is a member or within one year afterwards for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Club contracted before the time at which he ceases to be a Member and of the cost, charges and expenses of winding up the same and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves, such amount as may be required not exceeding Rs. 1,000/-

- (5) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains after the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall be paid to or distributed among the Members of the Club in equal shares.

We the several persons, whose names and addresses are subscribed, are desirous of being formed into a Company in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association.
